Abstract: The growth mindset was a concept developed by Stanford psychology professor, Carol Dweck. Standing in opposite to the fixed mindset which views a person’s ability, intelligence, and personality as a fixed asset inherited at birth and determined by the genes, the growth mindset believes these so-viewed fixed assets are, in fact, not fixed but can be developed, with unknown limit, through targeted efforts and deliberate practices cavitated by instructors.

The sharing will discuss approaches and strategies for cultivating the growth mindset in the chemistry courses at DKU. Specific examples of classroom activities and assignments will be given, designed to stimulate targeted efforts and help students see the role of such efforts play in their achievements.
